

**Special Rules and Certification Form
for NC Soybean Contest entries
that may exceed 100 Bu/A**

Special Rules: To be eligible for the \$2,500 (or \$5,000) bonus for having the highest yield over 100 Bu/A (a one-time only bonus), the field must be measured by 2 people who reside in 2 different counties. Both must be a member of their county's Soybean Contest Committee, and at least one must be a county Cooperative Extension agent. Both will sign the certification form attesting to the accuracy of the data used to calculate yield. The names of the two people who measured the field, the person who weighed the harvested soybeans, and the person who determined moisture (to the nearest tenth of a percent) and foreign matter (to the nearest whole percent) of the harvested soybeans will be noted on the contest application, and will be available to the public for all yields of 100 Bu/A or more. Field measurements must be made with a tape measure (not a measuring wheel), and determined to the nearest inch, tenth of a foot, or link. Deviations from the one-contiguous-area rule will not be permitted.
